NEW CASTLE 100 ARCHERS CLUB

All new members will be probationary members for a period of two (2) years. During this period these members cannot vote on constitutional and property provisions but all other membership privileges shall remain the same.

New members pay an initiation fee of one hundred fifty dollars plus dues. Dues for regular members are currently: **January thru June: \$100.00, July thru September \$50.00, October thru November: \$25.00, December \$100 (to include the following year).** Both payable upon submission of Membership Application. Membership includes your spouse and children (until age 18) under the supervision and responsibility of the parent member of the Club.

We have a lifetime membership (\$1,000.00 and 5 work hours per year), senior membership (50% off dues, 5 work hours per year).

You are responsible for ten (10) hours of productive work a year or pay \$20.00 an hour for hours not worked. Senior members (65 and up) are responsible for five (5) work hours, and senior members 70 and up have no work hour requirements.

All members are responsible to sell a minimum of 3 calendars (\$35 each) each year. Calendars are pro rated the first year: **January thru June: 3 Calendars; July thru September: 2 calendars, October thru November: 1 calendar; December: 3 calendars combined with the following year.** Senior members are not obligated to sell calendars.

New member work responsibility requirements are prorated during the year as follows: January through June - **TEN (10) HOURS; July through September-- SIX (6) HOURS; October through November – THREE HOURS (3); December – NO (0) Hours.**

Work sheets must be filled out to receive credit for work.

We own property, we have a clubhouse with running water, kitchen, bathrooms, and a telephone, C-van for 3-D storage, 6 wheeler and trailer for putting 3-D targets out for shoots and also used for work parties.

Every member has a key to the clubhouse and combination to the front gate. Only officers and committee persons have other keys and combinations. Vehicles are parked in the parking lot only, no driving on club grounds.

We have a practice range and 28 walk through targets in the woods. Remember this, you never walk a course backwards, if you start on 15 you go to 16, and so on.

There are three (3) tree stands with walk up stairs. Only the stand to the right of the clubhouse is used for broad head shooting. This is the only place you are allowed to shoot broad heads on club property.

There is no hunting on club property, or killing of any wildlife. No shooting at anything but targets at designated places. Safety is always first.

As a member you may bring guests and show them your club. They can shoot their bow with you. **THIS IS A ONE TIME ONLY PER GUEST.** To return they must become a member or pay a gues fee of \$10 per day.

The club offers place to shoot your bow. Any questions?
